## Daniel 9 & John 12 / Sunday, March 18<sup>th</sup>

1. Daniel was still in Babylon. And after reading the writings of Jeremiah he estimated that Israel's time for \_\_\_\_\_ and return was near.
2. Five days before the Passover each Jewish family would select a Lamb and set it aside for sacrifice. 3. By waving \_\_\_\_\_ branches (a Jewish national symbol) the people hailed Jesus as the Davidic king and echoed the language of Ps. 118:25-26.
4. John 12 (Palm Sunday) is the last prophetic \_\_\_\_\_ declaring to the Jews that their Messiah has come
