V:28 The Roman Catholic prayer that begins "Hail Mary, full grace" is accurate. Mary was full of grace, and so is the believer. B Mary's grace was a grace, not grace to others. – Guzik
Jesus means, "Jehovah is"
Jesus is not just "" son of God. He is "" Son
V:35 The word means "to cov with a cloud," as in the cloud of God's Shekinah_ (Exodus 16:10, 19:9, 24:16, 34:5, 40:34) or the cloud of God's Mark 9:7, Luke 9:3-
