1.) Have you ever felt judged or condemned by a religious person or system? How did you deal with it?

3.) Read Sunday's text (Luke 22:63-71) Also read the other Gospel writers accounts. (Matt. 26:57-68; Mark 14:61-64; John 18:12-14, 19-24) What important lessons stand out to you in these texts?

4.) Explore the various scriptures describing Jesus as the son of God and discuss their significance. (1 John 4:15, 5:9-13; John 5:24-29) As time permits explore what some of the prophets said about the Messiah (Psalm 69:4, 7-9; Isaiah 50:5b-6; Daniel 7:13-14; Isaiah 53)

5.) How might you summarize Sunday's bible lesson in a sentence or two? What are the key and most important lessons to apply to your life from this study?
