- 3.) Read Sunday’s text (Luke 24:36-52) What stand out to you most in this text?
- 4.) Pick out some of the following topics and scriptures and discuss their relationship to Sunday’s text and your life. Concerning **the believer’s resurrected body** 1 Cor 15:35-57. The need of **Repentance for the forgiveness of sins** Acts 5:31; 10:43; 13:38; 26:18. **The hope of the return of the Lord** Dan. 7:13; Mark 13:26; Luke 21:27; [John 14:3]; 2 Thess. 1:10; Rev. 1:7.
For further study on **Jesus’ Appearances after His Resurrection** Mark 16:12-13; John 20:19-25. After Jesus’ resurrection, he appears to several women at the tomb outside Jerusalem - Luke 24:1-12; Matt 28:1-10; Mark 16:1-8; John 20:1-18. Later that day he appeared to two disciples on their way to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-34) and then to most of the disciples in Jerusalem (Luke 24:35-49; John 20:19-39). Later Jesus appeared in Galilee (Matt 28:16-17; John 21:1-23). Finally, Jesus led his disciples to the Mount of Olives, from where he ascended to heaven (Luke 24:50-51; Acts 1:6-12).
