5.	Paul raised Timothy up in the faith. He was also responsible to train him in the faith. Do you have a Timothy in your life? Do you have a Paul in your life? Tell us about it. Avoid names when appropriate.

15. Dig Deeper: Paul was instructing Timothy how to handle the "Judaizers." What can you find out about these Judaizers?
16. In the present, what are some of the rules that churches put on people that are not part of the gospel?
17. Verses 12-17. Also read Acts 7:54-60, Acts 8:1-3, Acts 9:1-22. Who was Saul/Paul before he met Jesus?
18. In 1 Timothy 1:13, why did Paul receive mercy?

19. Who was Saul/Paul after he met Jesus?
20. Who were you before you met Jesus? Who are you now?
21. Verses 18-20. We see that in the past, a prophecy had been given to Timothy concerning his ministry. Have you ever had a prophecy spoken over you? Have you ever been given a prophetic word to speak? Tell us about it.
22. What do you think "made shipwreck of their faith" mean? How do we avoid doing this?
23. In this section we also look at Hymenaeus and Alexander. What did they do?
24. In verse 20, what did Paul do? What does that mean?
25. What about those of us who after we have accepted Jesus, turn back into sin or the world? Read 1John 1:9.
